Pathway Homes offers a broad continuum of housing programs, ranging from highly intensive to highly independent residential settings. Services are provided in a variety of settings to include single-family homes, townhouses, condominiums and apartments. We also provide support services to individuals living independently in the community. Our talented and committed counselors provide an array of support services to help each individual develop the needed skills and build the necessary confidence to achieve the greatest level of self-sufficiency and fulfillment possible.

Programs Include:

- Assisted Living Facility
- Intensive services in single-family homes
- Moderate-level and drop-in services in shared housing and apartments
- Consumer-directed housing
- Moderate-level and drop-in services in housing designated for individuals who are homeless
- Support services for individuals residing in independent housing
